SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI - Frances L. Cooper Rasnake, 96, was promoted to her heavenly home on Sunday, February 17, 2019.

She was born in St. Paul, Virginia; daughter of the late R. C. and Gertrude Castle Cooper. She was preceded in death by her husband, Clinton B. Rasnake; one sister, Lois Cooper Porter; a daughter-in-law, Delores Boulware Rasnake; and a son-in-law, Jack L. Brittan. She attended Dante Central High School in Dante, Virginia, where shortly after her graduation she married Clinton B. Rasnake. She and Clinton taught the new converts class and were youth leaders while she also served as the Women's Ministries President and as Sunday School Treasurer.

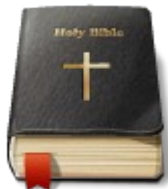
